Unfortunately, Christopher's story is one of many. Throughout our community, families and individuals are grappling with the pain of losing loved ones to suicide or coping with the immense pressures of mental health challenges. It is more crucial than ever that we unite to shed light on these issues, support each other, and work toward creating a healthier, more open environment for all.

The purpose of this golf tournament is to raise funds for vital mental health and suicide prevention programs in schools and throughout the community. Last year's efforts brought "Cory Greenwood Speaks", a music-based, participatory presentation to 10 schools across Herkimer County, directly engaging students in discussions and activities around mental health and well-being. Funds raised also sponsored a Summer Self-Care Club, field trips for at-risk youth, youth sports clinics, and participation and resource giveaways at multiple mental health fairs within schools and the community, just to name a few.
